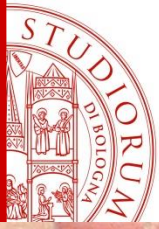

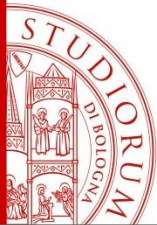

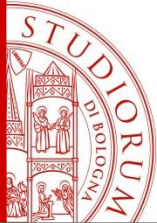

# CONSTITUENT PRINCIPLES

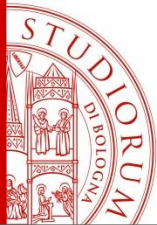
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In conformity with the principles of the Italian Constitution, Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna is a **public, independent, non-denominational and pluralistic institution.**

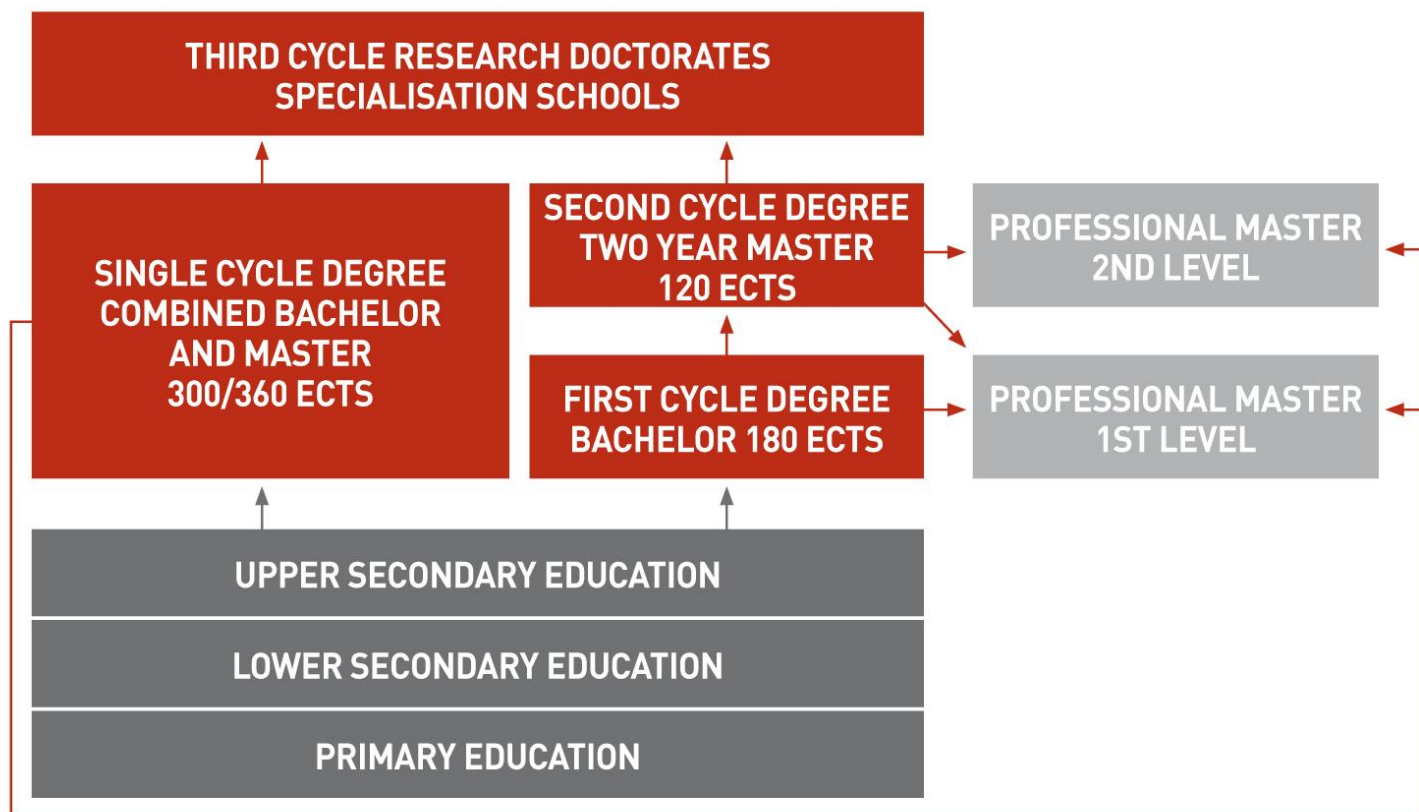

## University Library Organisation

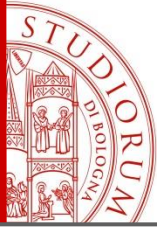

## ARGENTINA

The Alma Mater is **the first experience of an Italian university branch abroad**. It coordinates important research programmes, post graduate projects and academic collaboration with Latin America.



## CHINA

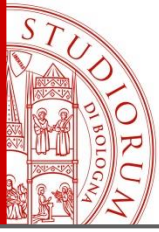
The University of Bologna hosts one of Italy's most active branches of the **Confucius Institute**, and was recognised as **the best of 2012**. Local relations of the **more than 800 Chinese students** at Bologna are supported by the "Collegio di Cina" Association.



## BRAZIL

The University was chosen by the Brazilian Government as national contact for the **Science without borders project**, involving **24** Universities, the National Research Council, Telecom Italia, the BIOGEM Research Centre and the National Institute of Nuclear Physics. Between 2011 and 2014 the University of Bologna coordinated the arrival of **3,296** grant recipients in Italy.

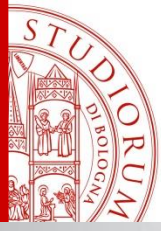




# INSTITUTE FOR ADVANCED STUDIES
